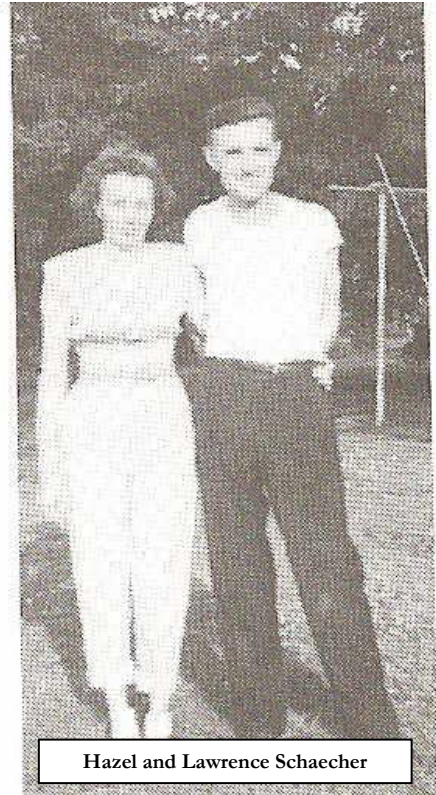
Hazel Louise Price

Hazel Louise Price, daughter of Ruby Rebecca Hoskins and William John Price, was born on 26 Mar 1923 in St. Louis, Missouri.⁹ She lived with her family in 1930 at 1123 St. Louis Avenue, East St. Louis, St. Clair, Illinois. On 14 Oct 1939 she married **Lawrence W. Schaecher**.¹⁰ Lawrence, the son of William Ludwig Schaecher and Anna E. Biermann, was born on 12 Jun 1915 in Platte County Nebraska.¹¹ Hazel was under the age of 18 when they married, and her mother gave permission for the marriage to take place.

Following their marriage, the couple lived in Nankin, Wayne County, Michigan where Lawrence worked as a milk dumper in a creamery.¹² He enlisted in the US Navy on 18 Mar 1943 and was released on 18 Dec 1943.¹³ The next piece of information on the family comes from 1972 when Hazel and Lawrence lived in Westland, Michigan.¹⁴

Lawrence died in Westland on 28 Jul 1978.¹⁵ Three years later, Hazel married **Bud Wright** on 22 May 1981 in Van Buren,

His heart though, belonged to boating, particularly to wooden boats. He grew up on the water, sailing and boating. He fell in love with wooden boats watching a neighbor cruise aboard a 1932 Winthrop Warner raised deck cruiser named Happie. Dan has owned or captained eight wooden boats through the years, from a 15-foot Penn Yan to the former presidential yacht, USS Sequoia. "Every wooden boat makes a statement, says Wilson. "First, it's a statement of the architect and next a statement of the shipwright who made it with his own hands. Then the yacht

makes a statement of its own, how she looks and feels, how she sits in the water, and she will say where she comes from in heritage, craftsmanship and design."⁸⁸

He captained the former presidential yacht, the Sequoia, early during the President Ronald

Reagan term of office from 1981-1982 and then again in 1998. Sequoia was designed by Johan Trumpy and built by the Mathis Yacht Building Company in 1925.

At the same time he was a captain on the Sequoia, he owned and lived on the Sakonnet, a yacht built in Annapolis by Chance Marine Construction and launched in October 1929. It was the last boat to leave

the yard before the Great Depression began. Wilson put her back into supreme condition and for three years cruised Chesapeake Bay and North Carolina, all the while continuing his radio work out of a studio he built in the forepeak. Tapes were sent out from whichever post office was nearby. Clive Cussler, founder of the National Underwater and Marine Agency, hired the Sakonnet in the early 1980s as the lead boat in his quest to find the Confederate ironclad, USS Merrimack, in the Elizabeth River off Portsmouth, Virginia.

Following Cussler's successful search for the Merrimack, Wilson put the Sakonett back to work as a dinner cruise vessel, running out of the Baltimore harbor. From 1982-1988 Danny was owner and president of Sakonnet Cruises Inc. in Baltimore and Sakonett Caterers Inc. in Baltimore from 1985-1988. "I was able to exercise my hobby of inventive cooking, entertaining on the main deck by the bar,

and milling about with people, all of which I love to do. It was a very successful venture."⁸⁹

Over the years, Dan bought, restored, and sold many wooden boats but in 1994, he came full circle, buying the boat, Happie that had belonged to Cornelius "Happie" Miller, his family friend.

Dan died on 10 Dec 2018 at the University of Maryland Medical Center. Interment was at Oakdale Memorial Gardens in Davenport, Iowa.

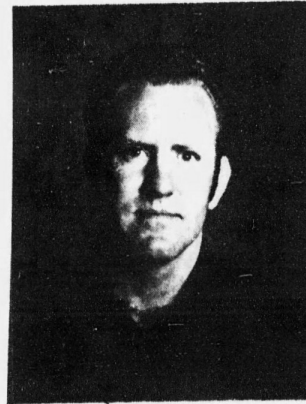

Garwood Go-Getter Wanted To Get Away From The Rat Race

"I moved from St. Louis to Garwood about a year and a half ago because I wanted to get away from the rat race," said Robert Copeland Jr., the owner of the Garwood store, as this reporter questioned him last weekend. Since moving from the city he has slowed down doing the following: He is a full time pastor of Liberty Baptist Church and preaches twice on Sunday and again on Wednesday evenings, he also holds study classes on Tuesday evenings and occasionally like last Saturday evening presides over a wedding. He holds a five day a week job in the local saw mill and on non-church evenings helps his wife Frances operate their store until closing. On Saturdays he also is a storekeeper. The Copelands told us that during the summer

the store is open until usually 10:30 or until everyone decides to go home. During the winter they usually close at 7 or 8 unless there is a Van Buren ball game when the store is closed promptly at 6 p.m., so the family can cheer on their favorite team. Robert himself once played on the Van Buren team but as for grade school he laughingly asserts that he is a Garwood Tech. Graduate. The general store they operate provides many services as well as food. There are two gasoline pumps out front, they sell cattle feed, people food, and this reporter even noticed a Notary sign hanging inside. It's also a school bus transfer point.

The Garwood store itself is a very old building that has been moved several times the

last time being sometime between 1900 and 1910 where it is now sitting. The store has been a lot of history pass by because at one time Garwood was a large lumber company development complete with a boarding house, telephones, a rail road and many homes, a blacksmith, and the store itself was a company store where company money was used to purchase the necessities of life. The Copelands still have a remembrance of that era in a 50 cent company coin. At one time the town we now call Garwood was called Tip-Top. No one is sure why the name was changed. Near the store is a well that is 812 feet deep. It supplied the entire town with water pumping a 4 inch stream 24 hours a day. But that was many years ago and now perhaps the towns only

claim to fame is the fact that almost everyone in town drives a red convertible---well, three out of four families drive a red convertible. There are now four families living in Garwood, awhile back one of the convertible owners sold his red convertible but it was purchased by a member of one of the other three families so Garwood's record remains unblemished.

Sometime if you get the chance stop by the Garwood Store and say hello to Robert and Frances Copeland and their three youngsters. That is if Robert is around you can say hi to him, if the pace that he sets for himself here in the country is slower than it was in the city this reporter would be willing to bet that all anyone saw up there of him was a blur.

'Fastest desktop computer'

Petaluma man says it's for real

PETALUMA — With some creative luck, Ed Karns gathered a few key parts and put together what he claims is the "fastest desktop computer in the world."

"It was a stroke of luck that I discovered the right combination of accessories and components to produce the world's fastest unit," said Karns, 44-year-old inventor of the Real Computer in Petaluma.

He claims his desktop units perform faster than any major brands now on the market.

And speed may be essential for engineers or lab technicians who want data or analyses quickly, said Karns, who began working on computers in 1963.

"All the parts are off the shelf and 75 percent American made," he said. "It's 60 percent faster than Compaq's fastest machine and 75 percent faster than IBM's fastest desktop."

Karns completed his first production run of six "Real" Computers, working at a store called Real Computers, operated by his wife Lisa, at 155 Petaluma Blvd N.

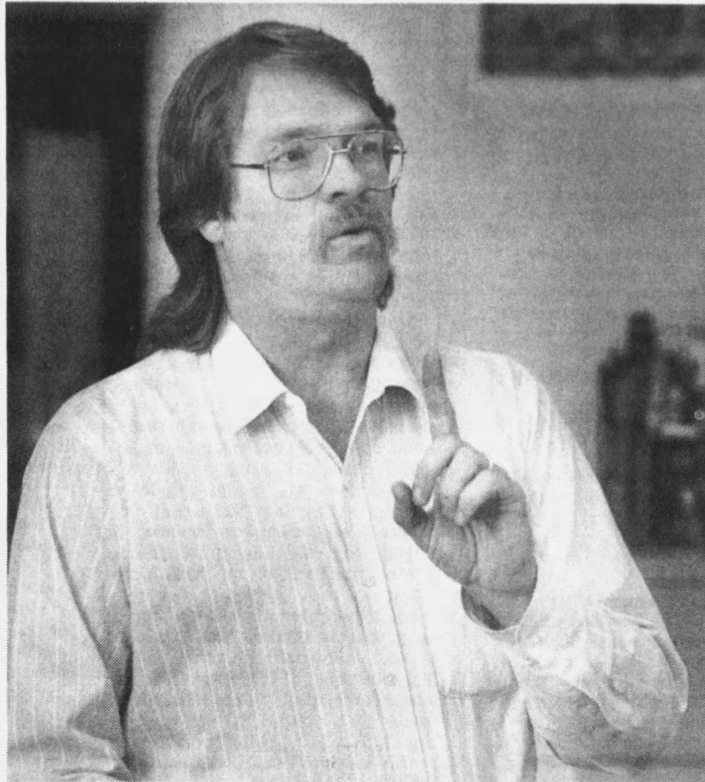
He said his company garnered about \$300,000 during its last fiscal year and he hopes to double that this year.

Since the Real Fast system is built to military specifications, it's not surprising to find that his customer list includes the CIA, Navy and Air Force.

Five of the first six units have been sold. Karns plans to make 10 to 15 more units in the next few weeks. He hopes to expand production up to 500 units next year.

Such a demand can be met, he says. Karns and two employees can produce one desktop computer in about an hour and assemble about five a day, he says.

"We call our system the Real Fast

supply, mother board and a hard and floppy disk drive controller," Karns said.

The display screen, power unit and hard disk comes with a price tag of about \$3,500.

Karns started working with computers in 1963 and wound up working for Computer Maintenance Service in San

Funeral Held In Ohio For Son-In-Law of Local Couple

Death was due to cyanide poisoning, apparently self-inflicted. No inquest was held. Mr. Limber was a medical technician at the hospital in Festus, and would have had knowledge of the chemicals which had been mixed inside the car to produced the deadly poison gas. The doors and windows of his car were all closed when his body was discovered.

Mrs. Limber and their 16-month-old son, Troy, had been here visiting her parents the weekend of Aug. 13th, and had returned to Festus on Tuesday. Friends had visited them early in the evening, and he had seemed in good spirits. It was reported that he left their home after 9 p.m., presumably to go to the hospital. His parked car was found early the next morning near the schoolhouse, only a short distance from the home.

Also attending the service in Ohio were Mrs. Limber's sister, Mrs. Jim Oesch and Mr. Oesch of Columbia, Mo.

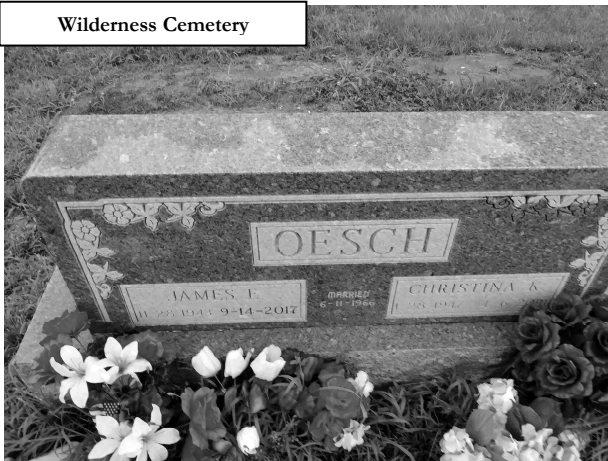

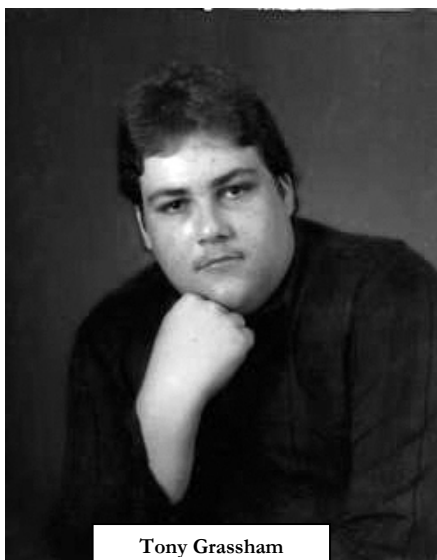

Keith works for AT&T/Southwestern Bell and the family lived in St. Louis, Missouri and San Antonio, Texas.



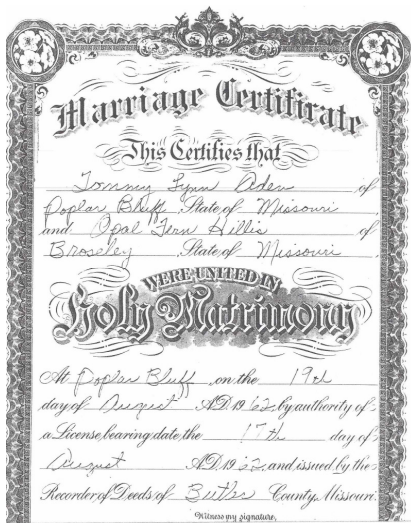

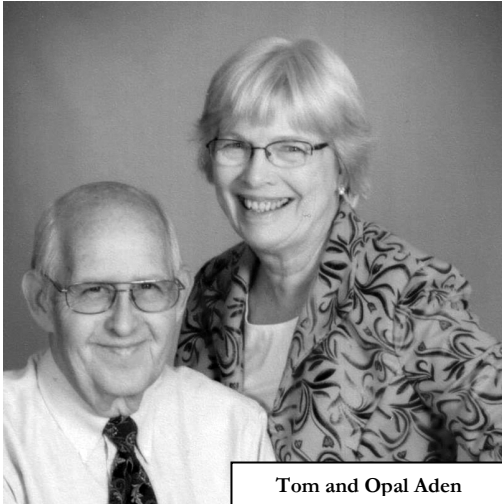
When Tom's father came home from World War II, the family moved from their apartment at Sixth and Main Streets to a shell-house on eight acres

Tom and Opal live in Cape Girardeau and stay busy with family including children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren.



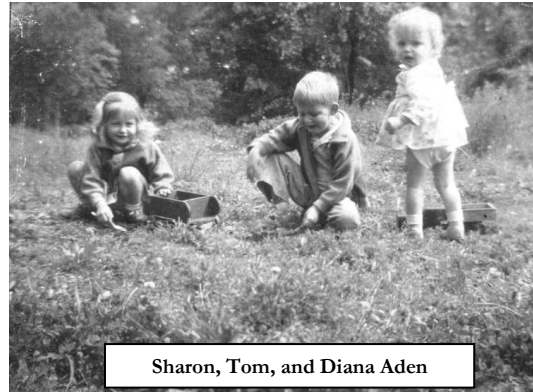
